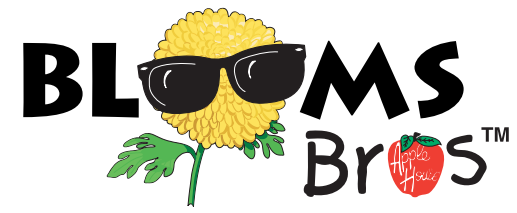





<p>29 <b>Avoid watering lawns at night.</b> -Morning is best.</p> 	<p>30 </p>	<p>31 <b>Annual Flowers Not Getting Bigger?</b> Annuals planted in May could be stunted due to a natural growth regulating a hormone called Auxin. These reside in upper buds and some upper leaves.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prune annuals by one-third</li> <li>• Fertilize with Miracle Gro® Bloom Booster®, liquid or granular</li> <li>• Water well to reduce stress</li> <li>• Water as needed but at least 2-3 times per week.</li> <li>• Petunias, geraniums, impatiens, marigolds &amp; zinnias respond well.</li> </ul>
