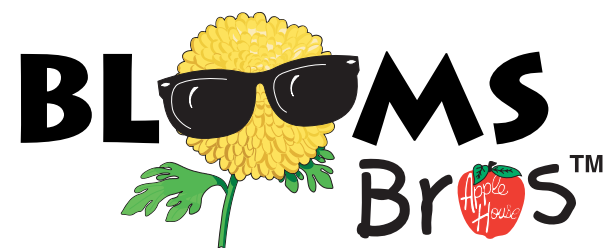

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<p>Now is the time for a second pinch on Hardy Mums!</p> 	<p>BAGWORMS ARE NOW HATCHING through mid-July. The young bagworms feed voraciously while beginning their cycle and are most vulnerable now. This will save you a lot of work in July and August. Use ROUNDUP® in landscape and gardens for quick control. See us for instructions. 2.
