

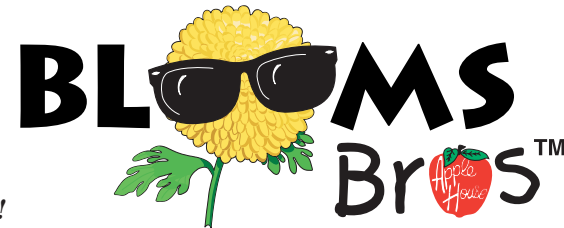


# September

**Did you plant new trees, shrubs or evergreens this spring?**  
It's critical to continue weekly soakings through mid October for continued plant health.

- Be sure bulbs are firm
- Be creative with sharp color contrasts in tulips

your houseplants now to remove insects before they come indoors!  
3x, 10 days apart

**13 Move your houseplants indoors within the next two weeks.**  
Make final spray a week before you bring them in.  
**DO NOT** fertilize again until February.

**15 Time to cut back Peonies.**  
Also, if 3-4 years old, now would be a good time to renew by division.



**16 Fall is a great time to divide many varieties of perennials for renewed vigor.**

**17** Every year about this time, several varieties of needled Evergreens start to show yellowing and browning foliage, mainly on interior needles. This is normal and similar to deciduous trees losing their leaves.  
**NO ACTION IS NEEDED FOR THESE CHANGES.**

**21 Poor flower production in older perennials indicates the time to divide.**

**23** **Establish winter bird feeding patterns in late September or October.**  
Birds are creatures of habit.

**30 Now is the time to fertilize.**
